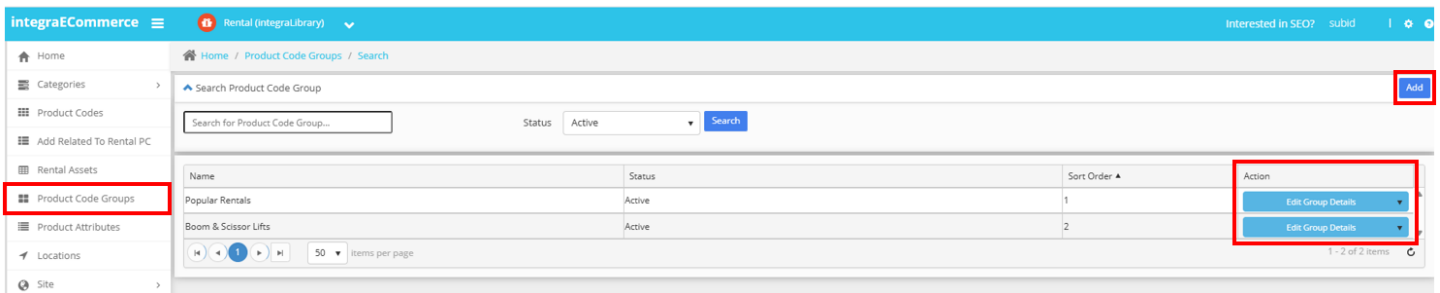


Product Code Groups


Product code groups serve a couple of different functions. You can use product code groups to display product carousels, known in our software as “sliders” or groups may be used for an alternative navigation for your customers on the left-hand side of your eRental site. This guide will explain how to set up, manage, and add product code pages to groups.

Adding/Editing Product Code Groups

Click Product Code Groups link in the menu, to view/edit existing product code groups or click the add button to create a new group.



Product Code Group Add/Edit Page




1. **Group Name** – this is used to identify the group and used as the title above the product code group slider once placed on a landing page.
2. **Sort Order** – this determines the order the groups show up in the alternative navigation.
3. **Active Checkbox** – this controls whether a group is active (live) or not (hidden).
4. **Template** – there is currently only one template: standard. You can ignore this field.
5. **Default Product Sort Order** – this controls how the products are sorted in the slider carousel. You can sort alphanumerically by product code title, or alphanumerically by product code id (usually this is the rental asset master id from integraRental).

6. **Cancel** – this cancels changes and returns you to the previous screen.
7. **Save** – this saves your progress adding/editing this group
8. **Preview** – this opens a new tab to preview the product code group page.
9. **Publish** – press publish after you’ve saved your work, to take the changes live on the site.

SEO Tab

Product Code Groups have their own page and URL once published. The SEO tab allows you to provide important meta data to Google and other search engines to help index and categorize this page of your eRental site.

Publish History Tab

Images Tab

This tab shows enables you to add an image to the product group page's header similar to how category page header images work. You only need to upload the image to the large image field and the software will generate a small image after you save and publish the group. The image uploaded to the Large Image field will display on the product code landing page above any text or slider content. You can also add alt text meta data via the SEO Alt Image Text field.

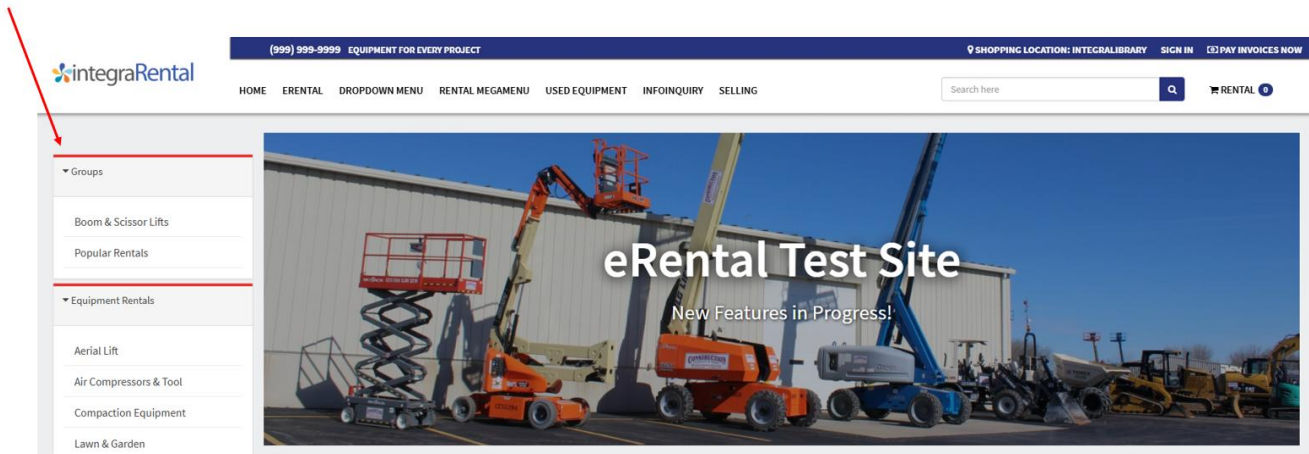

Landing Page

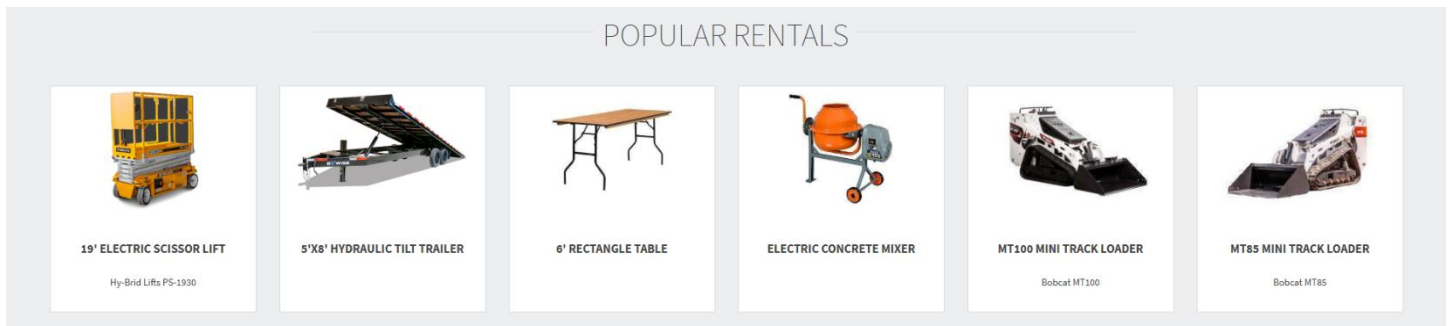
This tab allows you to customize the landing page for the product code group. This functions exactly like the main landing page and category landing pages. You have two sections you use to place content including the options to use the rich text editor or place additional product code sliders. As a precaution against duplicate content, we do not allow you to place a slider of the product code group you are editing on the same landing page. On the eRental site, users can navigate to a product code group landing page by either clicking the product group from the left hand navigation or by clicking on a product in a slider carousel and then clicking the group link in the breadcrumb.
