


## Landing Page – Base Category Card Widget

When this feature is turned on, your eRental site can display your base categories as card thumbnail links, beneath all existing content on the landing page. Both the image and the category name will automatically pull into this area. The image is pulled from the Large Image (on the category detail page) and the category name will automatically show. Both the image and the base category name will link to the expected category page. When you reorganize the order of your categories on the Category Tree page, these cards will update as well. When you rename or add/remove categories in the Category Tree, the cards will update as well. Run a full site publish after changes and then clear your cache / view your website in an incognito window to confirm it is displaying as below.






## Best Practices for Landing Page Base Category Cards

## **Images**

- 1. These are pulled from the Large Image on the <u>Category Detail</u>

  <u>Page (see bottom of page 3</u>) within iNextAdmin. Typically these large images will show on the category detail page of your live site. There is an ecom setting we can flip to turn off the large image from appearing on the category detail page, while still utilizing that large image for the product cards.
- 2. We recommend you use a square image (i.e. 800x800px) for the large image when adding large images to the category page to avoid image distortion in the cards on the landing page.
- 3. Before you ask integraSoft to turn on this feature, make sure you have large images set up for all base categories.
- 4. You may want to add a title above the cards. Use the very last widget on the landing page and you can start with this html for a nice title over the cards:
